Horizon Pet Boarding Boarding Agreement

The Arizona Veterinary Medical Examining Board REQUIRES that whenever a boarding facility is associated with a veterinary hospital that any animals that become "sick" must be transferred to the hospital for medical treatment. Some minor issues, such as stress related diarrhea can be treated with simple medication in the kennel and do not require doctor supervision.

Other minor problems such as eye infections, ear infections and skin irritations will require a doctor's examination in order to identify the proper treatment. In this circumstance you will be charged for an office exam and the costs of treatment. In the unlikely event of a more serious problem, your pet will be transferred from the kennel to the hospital. In all circumstances we will make every effort to contact you.

During playtime we may feed your pet house treats as a reward. If your pet has allergies that might be aggravated by receiving treats, please let us know during the pet's check-in exam.

Please understand that some pets might find boarding to be stressful, and consequently, may not eat as well as they do at home. To encourage pets to eat as normally as possible we occasionally add Iams Intestinal Low-Residue canned food to their meals.

We strongly discourage bringing personal belongings to the kennel. We will not be held responsible for lost, damaged or destroyed belongings. Clean bedding is provided daily and toys are available as well.

If your pet has a loose stool which appears to be stress related, we may add Forti Flora to your pet's diet. Forti Flora is a supplement of live naturally occurring microorganisms to promote intestinal health and balance. If the stool does not firm up, the veterinarian will be consulted.

All dogs and outdoor cats boarding at our facility are required to be treated for fleas and ticks within the last 30 days. Proof of current treatment is required (purchase receipt, a record from your veterinarian or a record from another boarding facility). If the current treatment expires during the time of your pet's stay it will be necessary for us to retreat them with Frontline Plus for a charge of \$15.00 per treatment.

All pets must be current on their vaccinations. If Horizon Animal Hospital is not your veterinary service provider then please furnish us with records of your pet's vaccination history. We require that Rabies and Distemper/Parvo (DA2pp for dogs) and rabies and distemper (FVRCP for cats) must be given within 36 months of boarding. Bordetella (Kennel Cough) must be given within 12 months. Please be aware that the Bordetella vaccine takes up to 4 days to become fully effective and may not protect against all strains of canine cough or canine influenza.

By signing this agreement you acknowledge the aforementioned terms and conditions of boarding you pet(s) at Horizon Animal Hospital, that you understand that payment for services is due in full at the time of check out and that you accept all the Terms and Conditions of the Horizon Animal Hospital Retail Credit Agreement.
